**CANCELLATION PENALTIES**

A \$100.00 per person cancellation fee will apply for any cancellation received after 09/17/10 and prior to 1/14/11.

A \$250.00 per person cancellation fee will apply for any cancellation received after 01/14/11 and prior to 4/08/11.

No refunds will be given for cancellations received after 4/08/11 or for "NO SHOWS" on day of departure.

***Cancellation penalties apply for any reason including, but not limited to, cancellation by the school, Board of Education, Superintendent, Parish, district or any other official; expulsion, suspension or any reason that a student is unable or not allowed to participate in the tour.***

**TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN**

Trip cancellation insurance is available and will provide you with coverage in the event you must cancel your trip due to unforeseen covered reasons. The cost for this coverage is \$34.00 and is due with the 1<sup>st</sup> deposit.

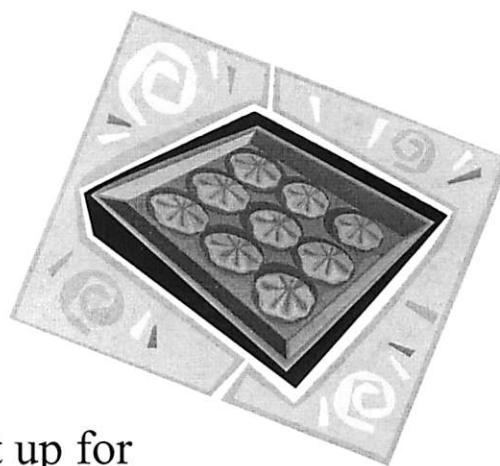

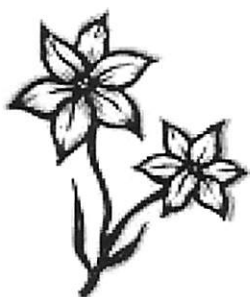
