

Summer Reading Assignment

Dear Parents,

The summer reading assignment for students entering sixth grade in the fall is as follows:

1. We recommend that each child read at least five books during the summer; however, there is a minimum requirement of one age appropriate book.
2. Keep a log of the books that have been read during the summer.* Every 150 pages of reading counts as one book; (example a book of 600 pages equals four books).
3. Your signature attests that the books were read.
4. Books must actually be *read*, not listened to on a CD, audiocassette or watched as a movie.

This assignment will count as the first homework assignment in reading class.

The book log must be turned in on or before the first Friday of school.

We hope that allowing students to choose their own books will make their summer reading enjoyable while keeping their reading skills fresh.
